General Rules:

This show is accredited and conducted under the 2025 rules and regulations of the American Shetland Pony Club. All horses must be registered with ASPC/AMHR/ASPR UNLESS showing in those classes noted for non-registered horses. The miniature and classic classes will have 3 judges. The Modern, Modern Pleasure and Show Pony classes will only have 2 judges. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st – 6th place. Championship Ribbons will be awarded Champions, Reserve Champions, Grand Champions, Reserve Grand Champions and Champion of Champions.

Coggins / Health papers: Coggins and Health papers are required at the facility. All out of state horses must have a 30-day health paper and 1 year coggins. Please follow current Georgia State regulations requirements for coggins and health papers. Please note that requirements for out of state horses differ from in-state horses.

Arrival Time:

No arrivals prior to 10:00 a.m. on April 6th without prior permission. If you need to arrive before this time, please contact the show manager. Anyone who occupies a stall prior to 10:00 a.m. on Sunday will be charged \$15.00 per stall

Shavings: Straw is not permitted for bedding. Shavings may be purchased from the facility and may be ordered with your entries. A limited number of shavings will be available at the show. Outside shavings are allowed.

Youth Classes:

Youth may show without a membership, but all youth must have an ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Youth number to be eligible for any ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Youth Awards. An application may be filled out with the ASPC/AMHR/ASPR to apply. Applications are available from the show steward.

Amateur Classes:

An ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$25.00 if applied for at the show. Exhibitors must be a member of ASPC/AMHR/ASPR to apply. Applications are available from the show steward.

Unlimited Class Fee:

Unlimited class fee is for OBMHC members only. **OBMHC Member** = owner of the Horse. Membership **MUST** be paid before or with entries.

Measuring:

Measuring will be from 4:00 – 7:00 on Sunday, April 6th and starting at 7:00 a.m. April 7th and as needed throughout the show. All horses must be measured or present a valid measurement card. Exhibitor numbers will not be given unless the measurement requirement is met. **A check or credit card number MUST be on file prior to getting exhibitor numbers.**

Show Office:

The show office will open at 7:00 a.m. and close between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. to prepare show staff for the start of the show. The show office will remain open for at least 1 hour following the show. Show Manager will be staying on the grounds if an issue arrives prior to or after the show office is closed.

Registration Papers: A copy of registration papers (front and back) must be included with your entry form. Your horse will not be entered without registration papers with the exception of weanlings. All paperwork must be up to date. Geldings must have their status documented on their papers in order to show.

Entries Due: Entry deadline is March 20th. All entry forms, copies of BOTH sides of registration papers of each horse, copy of youth and /or Amateur cards, copy of measurement cards if measured in 2025. Entries can be emailed, Facebook messenger or texted by **March 20th** and confirmation of entries will be sent back. If you do not receive confirmation within 24 hours, please call or text Lisa at 270-929-6292. Once entries have been received by email or text the appropriate fees are expected to be paid at the end of the show. If for unknown reason you're unable to attend after entries have been sent in you will be responsible for the following: stall, office, and shavings fees. Checks are to be made payable to Orange Blossom Miniature Horse Club. PayPal is also accepted with 5% fees – OBMHC2019@gmail.com. **MUST** Show the office a PayPal receipt. Entries may also be paid by credit card with a 5% fee. The credit card authorization form **MUST** be filled out or be on file.

Returned Check: All show fees must be paid prior to any exhibitor numbers being issued. Returned checks are subject to a \$50 returned check fee.

Post Entries: Late entries postmarked after March 20th will be charged post entry fees. **Adds and Scratches must be recorded with the show secretary 15 classes prior to class changes.** Transfers of classes will not incur late fees and will be considered a "wash". Change of handler in Amateur and Youth classes must meet all Amateur and Youth participation requirements. No refunds given on any entries or fees.

Gate Policy: It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to check-in with the gate person and make sure you're on the class sheet. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy. The two-minute gate rule will be in effect for ALL Shows. The two-minute timing shall start when the last horse enters the ring. Exhibitors are encouraged to have the equipment and/or equine in the warmup area to reduce tack change delays. **If you need a tack hold, please tell the Gate Person.**

Dog Policy: All dogs **MUST** be confined or on a leash at ALL times. At no time will excessively barking or running loose be tolerated. All dogs must be current with health requirements. Dogs are not allowed in the arena or the stands.

Emergency Information: Local emergency 911 for human emergency care. Contact information for Emergency Farrier & Veterinarian will be posted at the show throughout the barns.

Special Needs Exhibitors:

Special needs exhibitors are welcome to show. We would appreciate advance notice if any special arrangements need to be made. Please contact the show manager.

Conduct:

Cruelty, abuse, or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the grounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.

Liability Statement:

NEMHS, Southeastern Arena, show management, any officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest driver, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at this show. THIS SHALL BE A CONDITION OF ENTRY to this show or show grounds. WARNING under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
